

Tips for buying plane tickets

- 1) Your plane ticket is your first priority! The earlier you can purchase your ticket... the better! Unlike cruise tickets, airline tickets are usually more expensive when buying last minute.
- 2) Consider applying for the Airline Credit Card (or using a card you already have) when purchasing your tickets. We vacation annually! This means you can buy your tickets, pay the card off during the upcoming year and have it ready to use for the following years trip. This also allows you to rack up points on your card, which eventually can be used towards another trip, airfare, etc.
- 3) Always check and re-check to ensure that the flight that you have selected allows you to reach the departure port on time and for your return flight... ensure that you have enough time to reach the airport.
- 4) How are you traveling to and from the cruise departure port? There are taxis waiting outside of each airport that would gladly take you to the port (rates vary) or you can contact Carnival and reserve a spot on one of their shuttles.
